Student athletes of non-competing teams were allowed, if they chose, to use their student aid to continue in classes at our institution. Some chose to transfer to institutions at which they would be allowed to compete. For the students with cancelled seasons that chose to continue their studies at our institution men were awarded \$170,120 (55%) and women were awarded \$136,982 (45%) for a total of \$307,102 (in addition to the amount awarded to Track & Field / Cross Country).
