The New Mexico Junior College Board met on Monday, May 18, 2022, beginning at 2:30 p.m. in the Zia Board Room. Ms. Chappelle confirmed a quorum by roll call: Mr. Hector Baeza - present; Ms. Evelyn Rising - present; Mr. Travis Glenn, Secretary - present; Mrs. Erica Jones - present; Mr. Guy Kesner - present; Mr. Manny Gomez - present; and Ms. Pat Chappelle, Chair - present. Also, in attendance were Dr. Derek and Mrs. Pinkie Moore, and Ms. Dorothy Fowler.

Ms. Chappelle welcomed those in attendance and called the meeting to order.

Upon a motion by Mr. Glenn to omit item section "D. Closure of Open Meeting" of the agenda, seconded by Ms. Rising, the agenda was unanimously adopted as amended.

Upon a motion by Mr. Glenn, seconded by Mrs. Jones, the Board unanimously approved the appointment and naming of Dr. Derek Moore as the 7th President of New Mexico Junior College.

Upon a motion by Mr. Kesner, seconded by Mr. Gomez, the Board unanimously approved the proposed contract between New Mexico Junior College and Dr. Derek Moore with a beginning employment date of July 1, 2022. At this time, Ms. Chappelle and Dr. Moore executed the NMJC Presidential Contract.

Dr. McCleery called on Ms. Dorothy Fowler with the Hobbs News Sun to join Dr. Moore at the presenters table for questions.

Upon a motion by Ms. Rising, seconded by Mr. Gomez, and by unanimous consent, the meeting adjourned at 2:51 pm.

NEW MEXICO JUNIOR COLLEGE BOARD MEETING MAY 19, 2022 MINUTES

The New Mexico Junior College Board met on Thursday, May 19, 2022, beginning at 1:30 p.m. in the Pannell Library, Zia Board Room. The following members were present: Ms. Patricia Chappelle, Chair; Mr. Travis Glenn, Secretary; Ms. Evelyn Rising; Mr. Hector Baeza; Mr. Manny Gomez; Mr. Guy Kesner, and Mrs. Erica Jones.

Ms. Chappelle called the meeting to order and welcomed visitors and guests attending.

Upon a motion by Ms. Rising, seconded by Mr. Glenn, the agenda was unanimously adopted.

Upon a motion by Mr. Glenn, seconded by Mr. Gomez, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of April 14, 2022. Upon a motion by Mr. Gomez, seconded by Mr. Baeza, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of April 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 25, 2022 and May 13, 2022.

Under President's Report, Dr. McCleery invited Mr. Toby Spears and Mr. Doug McDaniel, with the City of Hobbs, to provide an update of the Center of Recreational Excellence (CORE) facility. Dr. McCleery stated NMJC currently maintains a 16% partnership of the CORE facility with the City of Hobbs, the Board of Education of Hobbs Municipal School District, and Lea County. Mr. Spears provided a Ballard King Study presentation of the CORE Funding Analysis and CORE Budget since inception through March 31, 2022. Mr. Gomez asked for clarification of the Ballard King Study and when the study was conducted. Mr. Spears responded the Ballard King Study consisted of the Maddox Foundation, partners of Lea County, HHS and the City of Hobbs, to establish the projected cost for a facility of this magnitude in Hobbs. Following a detailed presentation, Mr. Gomez stated the City of Hobbs staff have taken an initiative on cost containment to assure that subsidy level remains at a reasonable subsidy. He stated the key is in the Quality of Life initiatives in Lea County and the focus for sharing entities to get back on track and fund a reserve to provide for recurring and capital costs to maintain the CORE "State of the Art" facility. Dr. McCleery recommended reinventing of a Quality of Life Committee. Mr. McDaniel provided a history of attendance of past and upcoming events. Ms. Lyndsey Henderson, CORE Facility Director, provided updates of the programming aspects at the CORE.

Ms. Rising recognized Dr. Larchinee Turner, Professor of Biology, who is the recipient of the Excellence in Education Award by the Hobbs Branch NAACP. She further advised Dr. Turner will be recognized by the State in June of 2022 as the Outstanding Educator of the Year.

Dr. August Fons, City of Hobbs Police Chief and Mr. Walter Coburn, Director of Public Safety Programs presented a letter of appreciation from the Southeastern New Mexico Law Enforcement Academy Advisory (SNMLEA) Board to the NMJC Board and Dr. McCleery for the continued support the NMJC's Law Enforcement Training Program. SNMLEA thanked the Board for their

unwavering support, faith, and confidence in the past and future of the Law Enforcement Program. Dr. McCleery recognized Dr. Fons for the many years of service at NMJC before moving forward in 2019 with other opportunities. Dr. McCleery thanked Dr. Fons for his tenacity and dedication that he devoted while serving NMJC to create a premier Law Enforcement Program/Academy in the State of New Mexico. Dr. Fons personally expressed his appreciation for allowing him to continue to be a part of the program since its inception in 1996.

Mrs. Cathy Mitchell and Zamika Bradley provided a NMJC Student Life activities and events update. Ms. Bradley provided a presentation of student activities which included a Back to School Jamboree, Cupid's Shop for Valentines Day, homecoming week events throughout the week, Drug and Alcohol Awareness, Casino Night, Glow in the Park Easter Egg Hunt, Earth Day, Denim Day for Education of Sexual Awareness, Spring Farewell Festival, and the 2022 Academic & Leadership Award Ceremony.

Mrs. Cathy Mitchell and Angela Marmolejo provided an NMJC graduation update. Mrs. Mitchell shared photos of graduating students taken before and during graduation. Ms. Marmolejo provided graduation updates for the 2021/2022 school year. She reported 423 students applied for graduation, noting this includes students who applied for multiple degrees, 22 high school equivalency students, of that number, 307 different unique students which narrows down the duplicated numbers, of that number, 272 students who stated they would walk the stage and 261 students who actually walked. In 2019, 378 students applied for graduation, 270 students stated they would walk and 240 students walked. In 2018, 319 students stated they would walk and 233 students walked. She reported students were provided caps and gowns at no cost and is hopeful NMJC will be able to provide this in the future. Ms. Marmolejo reported graduation numbers, not including students who are still completing summer/fall semester, as follows: 355 awarded degrees, 98 Associate of Arts, 129 Associate of Science, 61 Associates of Applied Science, 67 certificates, 144 honor graduates with a 3.5 GPA or higher, and 31 students with more than one degree.

Mr. Deron Clark provided an athletics update. Mr. Clark reported on results from the NMJC Men's & Women's Outdoor Track Teams attending the National Outdoor Men's & Women's Track Meet in Hutchinson, KS. Ms. Alexa Contreras from Lovington, New Mexico, received an All-American for NJCAA in the women's pole vault. Women's track team finished 2nd and men's track team finished 9th. Mr. Clark provided updates from various NMJC graduate athletes and their accomplishments at Nationals. He announced at a NJCAA United States Track & Field Coaches Association Meeting, Coach Keith Blackwill was named the West Region Women's Coach of the Year, Coach Tabarie Henry was named the West Region Women's Assistant Coach of the Year, and Ms. Damaris Chewon was named the West Region Women's Track Athlete of the Year. He reported the NMJC baseball team finished 42/17 for the season overall, 24/8 in Conference and are WJCAC 2022 Champions. Spring team GPA was 3.22. Individual results for the team were provided to include those named to All-Conference Teams, All-Region Teams, NMJC Physics Award, NMJC Calculous Award, and various Academic All-American Awards. The NMJC golf team finished 4th with a team GPA of 3.7. There were 3 Academic All-American Awards which

will also be named as the NJCAA Golf Coaches Association President's Award for a team GPA of 3.5 or higher. The team finished 3rd in Conference and 4th Nationally.

Under New Business, Mr. Josh Morgan presented the April 2022 financial reports. Upon a motion by Mr. Kesner, seconded by Mr. Gomez, the Board unanimously approved the Expenditure Report for April 2022. In addition, the Revenue Report, Oil and Gas Revenue Report, and Schedule of Investments Report were reviewed.

Mr. Morgan presented consideration of the Five-Year Capital Plan to be submitted to HED in July and noted the Five-Year Capital Plan for NMJC follows the College's strategic and master plans. Mr. Morgan provided the top three priority projects as follows: 1) Air handler replacement at the Bob & Bonnie Moran Hall and the Pannell Library; 2) Roof replacement at Ben Alexander Student Center and the Bob & Bonnie Moran Hall; 3) Campus-wide site project which will include landscaping, site design, lighting, security and wayfinding. Administration requested approval of the Five-Year Capital plan as presented. Upon a by Mr. Gomez, seconded by Ms. Rising, the Board unanimously approved the Five-Year Capital Plan as presented.

Dr. McCleery requested consideration of the naming of NMJC's Vice President of Instruction position to Mr. Jeff McCool. Upon a motion by Mr. Kesner, seconded by Mrs. Jones, the Board unanimously approved this request.

Dr. McCleery requested, as part owner of the CORE facility, reaffirmation of the CORE Partnership Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) drafted and executed in 2015 between the City of Hobbs, The Board of Education of Hobbs Municipal School District, New Mexico Junior College, and Lea County for the Design, Construction, Operation and Joint use of a Health Wellness and Learning Center. Following acknowledgement, affirmation, and review of the CORE MOU, that NMJC will synergistically work with the City of Hobbs to create a short/long-term strategic funding plan for the CORE, that Mr. Josh Morgan and Mr. Toby Spears will begin discussions for long-term solutions for BR&R and ER&R, and that the MOU, the MOU's financial operation and the CORE partnership will be reviewed annually. Upon a motion by Ms. Rising, seconded by Mrs. Jones, the Board unanimously approved the CORE Partnership Reaffirmation of the MOU as presented.

As the Chair and on behalf of the Employee Benefits & Welfare Committee, Dean Dianne Marquez presented a request for consideration of President's Day holiday to be an official NMJC holiday beginning February 2023. Dr. Marquez noted the addition of this holiday will follow the Hobbs Public Schools holiday schedule. Mr. Holloman noted a change to the College Calendar and the revision to the NMJC policy will need to be presented for approval in the next Board meeting. Upon a motion by Mr. Gomez, seconded by Mrs. Jones, the Board unanimously approved this request as presented.

Mrs. Amy Coombes recommended Ms. Laura Hockensmith for the Museum Educator position at a salary of \$48,060. Upon a motion by Mr. Gomez, seconded by Mr. Kesner, the Board unanimously approved the recommendation of Laura Hockensmith effective May 16, 2022.

Mrs. Coombes recommended Ms. Cindi Stephenson for the Counselor position at a salary of \$75,000. Upon a motion by Mr. Glenn, seconded by Mr. Gomez, the Board unanimously approved the recommendation of Cindi Stephenson effective May 16, 2022.

Mrs. Coombes recommended Ms. Jessica Holladay for the Assistant Director for Bookstore Services position at a salary of \$36,635. Upon a motion by Ms. Rising, seconded by Mr. Gomez, the Board unanimously approved the recommendation of Jessica Holladay effective April 16, 2022.

Mrs. Coombes requested approval for employment of Ms. Leann Wynn, relative (sister-in-law) of Stacey Wynn, Controller, for the Bookstore Clerk position as per the NMJC Employee Handbook Policy No. 203 - Employment of Relatives. Upon a motion by Mr. Glenn, seconded by Mr. Gomez, the Board unanimously approved the employment of Leann Wynn.

Ms. Chappelle called for comments from the public. There being none, the next Regular Board Meeting was scheduled for Thursday, June 16, 2022 at 1:30 pm in the Zia Board Room.

RE: Expenditure and Revenue Reports for May 2022

May is month eleven or 91% of the budget for the 2021/2022 fiscal year. The Expenditure Report represents expenditure totals that include funds expended and encumbered. The total year-to-date funds expended and/or encumbered through the month of May is \$42,612,909.

The total current unrestricted fund expenditures through May are \$25,007,311, which is 76% of the projected budget. Instruction and General is higher compared to last year due to increase in salary costs in Institutional Support and Operation and Maintenance and because of an increase in utility costs. In other current unrestricted funds, expenses are also higher as compared to FY 21 due to an increase in food service costs and an increase in athletic expenses due to having all athletic sports competing this year compared to last year when only track was competing. Internal Services which consists of the Computer Services and the Document Center continue to receive monthly credits from Instruction & General to cover the operating costs. Auxiliary Enterprises will begin to have credits posting from return of books.

In the restricted funds, the expenditures in the grants area are higher than this time last year. This is due to the expensing of Institutional HEERF funds. The Business Office continues to monitor the expenditures in the grants and request the drawdown from the state and federal agencies. The year-to-date restricted student aid is higher than May 2021. This is due to the awarding of Student HEERF. Total amount of restricted funds expended through May 2022 is \$6,967,635.

Plant fund expenditures for May 2022 were \$308,453; the total year-to-date including encumbrances is \$10,637,963. Total plant funds expended include expenditures design work on the Campus Wide Site Project, the Vocational Training Facility, the Campus Housing Unit, and the Cafeteria.

Total expenditures and or encumbrances through May 2022 were \$42,612,909 or 77% of the budget.

Total current unrestricted revenue received in May 2022 was \$8,012,854, with the year-to-date total of \$72,347,777. This mostly consists of the monthly allocation from the state, the oil and gas income, and property tax revenue. Registration for the summer and fall opened in April. The tuition and fees collected in May 2022 for the summer and fall semesters was \$61,722. Oil and gas mill levy received in May for the month of February was \$5,896,935. The property tax revenue received in May was \$1,423,699. Looking at the past trends in property tax payout, the College should receive additional property tax revenue in June. In FY 21, the total for mill levy property tax was \$13,817,722.

There was \$53,520 drawn in for restricted Grant revenue in May, and \$10,043 in the Restricted Student Aid revenue. The total year-to-date revenue in the restricted funds is \$8,833,646.

In plant funds, there was \$54,730 received in LGIP interest income for May and \$9,178 was drawn down on the STB Vocational Training Building project for a total Plant revenue for the month of May of \$63,908 and year-to-date revenue of \$522,298.

Total revenue for the month of May 2022 is \$8,140,325, with year-to-date revenue of \$81,703,721 or 84% of projected revenue budget.

The total oil and gas and oil and gas equipment tax revenue received through May of 2022 including the accrual of \$465,000 for each of the three months of March, April and May is \$46,143,307.

The Investment Report shows a beginning balance and ending balance in LGIP funds of \$101,000,000. There was no activity during the month. The ending balance in the LGIP at the end of May is \$101,000,000. Allocated capital projects at the end of May were \$103,960,823.11 which includes the capital project transfers that were approved at the April 2022 board meeting.

This concludes the Financial Report for May 2022.

Overview/Objectives

The Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT) is pleased to submit a proposal to assist the New Mexico Junior College (NMJC) Board of Directors with its 2022 comprehensive presidential evaluation process. The governing board is responsible for the evaluation of the president and setting the compensation of the president. Evaluating and supporting the College president is among the board's most important responsibilities. The presidential evaluation process can strengthen and build the relationship between the board and the president and provides an opportunity to clarify the expectations of all board members.

Proposed Scope of Work

- **Evaluation Design:** ACCT will work with the designated NMJC board members and president to design a process that evaluates the president on core competencies, assess how well the president has performed in carrying out the board's policies and priorities, and to help set the stage to engage the board in aligning its goals and priorities with the College's strategic plan.
- Evaluation Process: The proposed evaluation will consist of two parts: Part 1: An ACCT representative will interview each board member following a specific protocol to evaluate the president's performance. The ACCT representative will work with the professional board liaison to arrange phone interviews with each board member. The ACCT representative will record in writing board member responses to a predetermined set of questions. ACCT will compile and summarize the responses and prepare a report for the board to review.

Part 2-A: ACCT, in collaboration with the board chair (or designee) and the president, will develop a customized evaluation instrument based on a Likert scale. ACCT will send an electronic link to the evaluation instrument to each member of the Board of Directors. The evaluation instrument may include specific items related to the president's leadership skills and core competencies. It may also include items related to the president's progress on the college's strategic goals.

Part 2-B: ACCT will distribute a separate link for the same evaluation instrument described in Part 2-A to selected members of the college and community. This group may include: direct reports to the President, some indirect reports, leaders of constituent groups such as the faculty leadership, classified staff, student representatives, foundation leaders, select members of the broader community, and others to be determined and mutually agreed upon. ACCT will prepare a confidential summary analysis of the data collected in Parts 2-A & 2-B disaggregated by group for the board to review.

• **Review:** An ACCT representative can meet in-person or virtually with the Board to review the results. This review will be scheduled on a mutually agreeable date and time. (Separate fee applies.)
