

2024-2025 Verification High School Completion Status

Provide <u>one</u> of the following documents that indicate the student's high school completion status when the student will begin college in 2024-2025. **DO NOT** send high school documentation until the student has graduated and the graduation date is on the official documentation.

- Official high school transcript can be sent by the High School to transcripts@nmjc.edu or the high school can mail the official transcript to the address noted at the bottom of this form.
- The **official state certificate or transcript** received by a student after the student passed a State-authorized examination that the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED test, HISET, TASC, or other State-authorized examination) can be emailed to transcripts@nmjc.edu or mailed to the address noted at the bottom of this form.
- Secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or other similar document can be emailed to transcripts@nmjc.edu or mailed to the address noted at the bottom of this form.
- DD Form 214 Certificate of release or Discharge from Active Duty that indicates high school
 graduate/equivalent can be emailed to transcripts@nmjc.edu or mailed to the address noted at the bottom of this
 form.
- Official college academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year
 college program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree can be mailed from the college to
 the address at the bottom of this form.
- Official homeschool in a state where state law requires the student to obtain a secondary school
 completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diplomas or its recognized equivalent), a
 copy of that credential can be emailed to transcripts@nmjc.edu or mailed to the address at the bottom of this
 form.
- Official homeschool in a state where state law does not require the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript, or the equivalent, signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses the student completed and includes a statement that the student successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting can be emailed to transcripts@nmjc.edu or mailed to the address at the bottom of this form.
