

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Only available to seniors currently attending school
- Must be currently attending a high school within Weld (co), Adams (co), Arapahoe (co), Broomfield (co), Larimer (co), Boulder (co), Morgan (co), Lea (NM), Eddy (NM), Reagan (TX), Loving (TX), Upton (TX), Glasscock (TX), Midland (TX), Ector (TX), or Martin (TX) Counties
- Must be pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited two- or four-year educational institution (https://ope.ed.gov/dapip/#/home)
- Must have strong commitment to community improvement
- Demonstrate leadership and integrity
- Current Civitas employees and their immediate families are not eligible to apply

HOW TO APPLY

To apply for the Civitas Foundation scholarship, interested students must complete the application form online. The completed application form, along with all required supporting documents, must be submitted by the specified deadline. After the deadline, all applications will be carefully reviewed by the scholarship committee, and winners will be notified via email.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Civitas Foundation scholarship program offers up to \$10,000 for one year to be applied at an accredited two- or four-year higher education program. The scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors. There is no minimum GPA required, although applicants must have demonstrated leadership skills and community involvement and a commitment to educational excellence. The scholarship funds can be used towards tuition, fees, books, and other educational expenses.
