The scholarship will be for \$1500.00 and will be paid according to the following:

- 1. The scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university for the full amount of the scholarship prior to the beginning of the fall semester and after verification of enrollment is received.
- 2. Contact the Brooke Parker Foundation in the event of an extenuating circumstance that requires withdrawal from school. The foundation will then decide if the scholarship shall be continued or forfeited.

Applicant Criteria

- 1. Must be a graduating senior in the West Texas or Southeast NM area and planning to attend any college or university.
- 2. Demonstrate a record of good spirit and works.
- 3. Submit a complete application to the high school counselor by the announced deadline of April 13th or to the Brooke Ashton Parker Scholarship Committee.
- 4. Be willing to abide by all criteria for payment of the scholarship.
- 5. Be willing to be interviewed by scholarship committed if requested.
