

CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR)

A CURRENT CPR CERTIFICATION CARD MUST BE ON FILE FOR THE DURATION OF NURSING EDUCATION. It is your responsibility to make sure that your card stays current. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL IT EXPIRES TO RENEW IT!!! The nursing faculty/secretary will not be responsible for keeping up with your certifications. We will be monitoring it to make sure you are in compliance. *If your card expires during the semester, you will not be eligible to attend clinical rotations and it could cause you to be unable to progress in the nursing program.*
