General Education requirements must be completed with a "D" or better. The student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0. Transitional courses do not fulfill any of the above requirements.

All courses, other than General Education requirements, must be completed with a "C" or better. A minimum of 15 semester hours must be earned at NMJC. The remainder may be acceptable transfer credits. Students will not be permitted to graduate if they have incomplete (I) grades on their academic record.

Be aware, many universities require a 2.8 grade point average and above to transfer.

Education students seeking a bachelor's degree should complete the Essential Academic Skills tests (3 subtests in reading, writing, and mathematics) as part of the National Evaluation Series Tests required by the New Mexico Public Education Department. Many four-year institutions require a passing score in order to be accepted into their departments of education.
